

Protecting God's Children® for Adults is training conducted by VIRTUS® certified facilitators on the prevention of child sexual abuse. The training makes participants aware of the signs of child sexual abuse, the methods and means by which offenders commit abuse, and five easy steps one can use to prevent child sexual abuse. Two videos are the centerpiece of the training: A Time to Protect God's Children™ and A Plan to Protect God's Children™. The facilitators incorporate policies and procedures into the training defining child sexual abuse, addressing the reporting of child sexual abuse, the screening and selection of employees and volunteers, and victim advocacv.

VIRTUS training is required for all church employees and any volunteers who will be working with or chaperoning children at our Parish. Training sessions are scheduled for Monday, August 5 and Wednesday, August 7 at 6:00 pm. The training generally last less than two hours.
