

Jesse Tree: An ancient tradition revived in the mid-20th century as an Advent practice, the Jesse Tree represents the family of Jesse, father of King David. Each day of Advent a homemade ornament is added to the Jesse Tree, a small tree, either of evergreen or bare branches. These symbolic ornaments each represent a prophecy foretelling of Christ.

We invite you to make this an Advent project for your family this year. Each week we highlight the members of Jesus' family tree, the symbol normally associated with them, and the scripture passage in the Bible where they can be found. There is a short description and prayer your family may wish to use.

The First Sunday of Advent – WATCH

The first week starts with the first stories of the Bible, God's creation of the world and of Adam and Eve, followed by Noah and his ark full of animals. The Saga of God's chosen people begins with the promises he made to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. God's concern for his people is expressed again through the story of Joseph and his coat of many colors

Prayer – O Lord, stir up your power and come! Rescue us from sin and all evil by your holy protection. Help us to prepare our hearts for your Son's new coming in grace this Christmas. We ask this through Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. Amen
