Parish ministry highlight: Ushers

Hospitality is an important role of the usher; being an usher is a ministry. The usher is usually the first person encountered when someone comes to mass so in essence they are greeters. The usher acts as concierge; showing people to a pew especially if the church is crowded, fielding questions and directing people to restrooms, confessional, etc.

The head usher: makes sure the attendance is counted and noted on the collection bag, makes sure there are enough people to do the collection and monitors the money is all put in the collection bag and taken up to the altar at offertory time. The collection is the offering of the people and, as such, should be proudly brought up and laid in front of the altar.

At the end of mass ushers hand out bulletins, thanks people for attending and make sure that the collection is safely delivered to the parish office. Wearing a nice jacket doesn't make an usher but it certainly allows visitors and regulars alike to recognize who they should address their questions to.
