

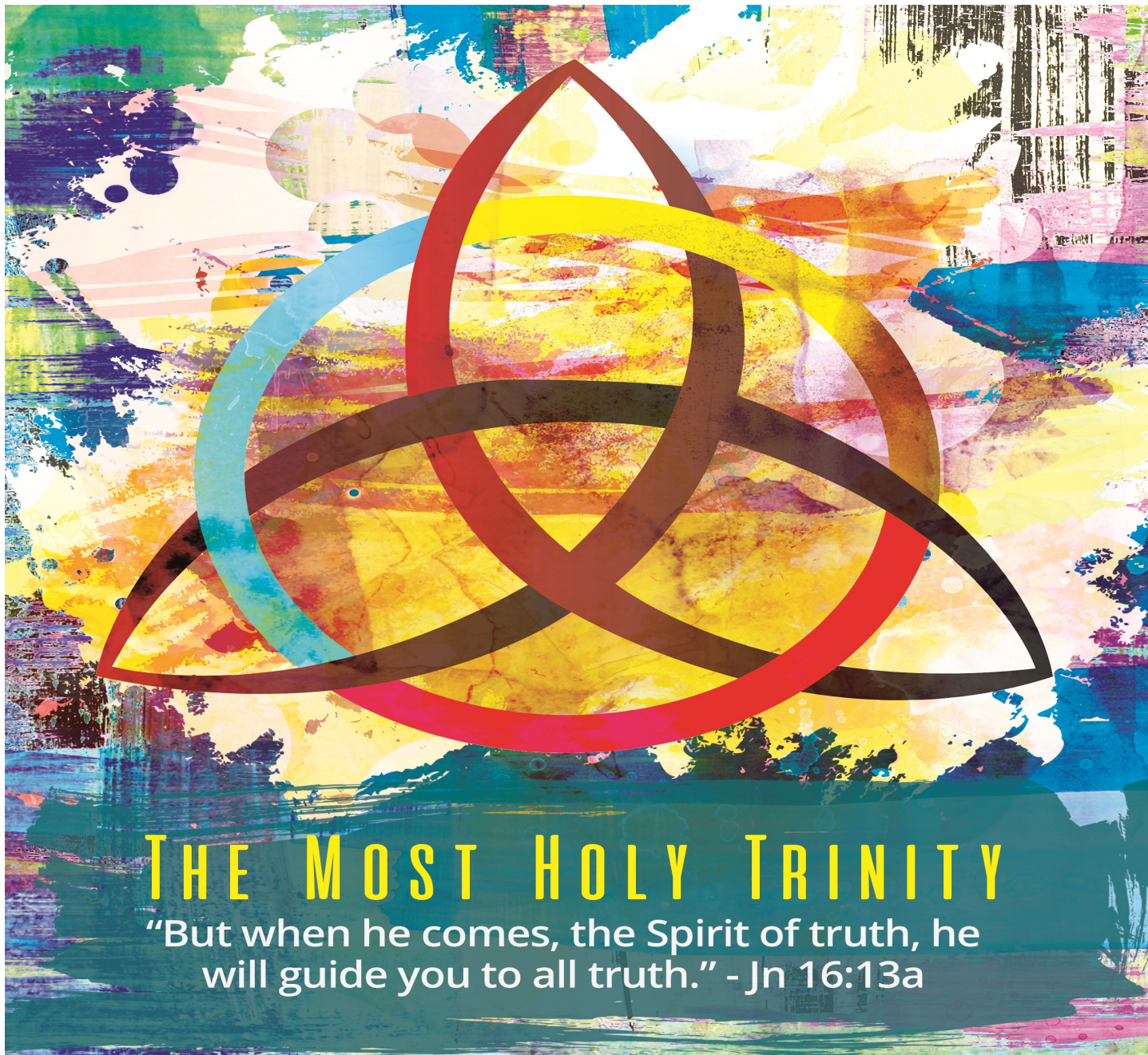

Safe Environment for our Children requires us to be ever vigilant. One of the ways we do this is to have Virtus training for Adults: all individuals (over the age of 18) who are **paid staff** at a parish, school or diocesan office, regardless of position, as well as those **volunteers** who have regular contact with children and youth, must as a condition of employment or volunteer participation, comply with the following: 1) undergo a criminal background check / social security verification 2) receive Virtus training within 60 days of commencing their employment or volunteer duties and have it renewed every five years, and 3) review the Guidelines for Appropriate Conduct and sign the Standard Code of Conduct. Examples of volunteers who must meet these requirements are: parent volunteers in diocesan schools, catechists, CYO coaches, boy/girls scout
